

June 6-7, 1944 6mm "Rommel" Scenario

BACKGROUND

By early 1944 the western allies pushed Hitler from North Africa and southern Italy—Mussolini had been arrested and imprisoned. But war planners in London and Washington knew that to complete their victory another much larger front needed to be established.

Across staging areas in southern England, the allies laid preparations for the largest amphibious invasion in history. Over a million troops would land in Normandy and begin the liberation of France, backed by overwhelming material superiority meant to end Nazi control once and for all. In the months leading to the invasion, elaborate deception and misinformation efforts worked to confuse the German high command.

Hitler and his top commander in the west, von Rundstedt, believed the allies would land at Calais—the nearest point to England. Erwin Rommel was brought to France to improve the Atlantic Wall defenses, and Rommel took to the task with energy.

On the night of June 5- 6^{th} , a massive airborne assault dropped three divisions into Normandy. Rommel, as it happened, was on leave in Germany at this critical time. Hitler was sleeping and his staff refused to wake him until late morning on the 6^{th} . Hitler alone had authority to release the German armored reserve.

GAME LENGTH

This scenario covers the June 5-6th drop (3 turns), all of June 6th (12 turns) and June 7th (12 turns). The allies win if they end any day in control of Bayeux, Carentan, and Caen. The Germans win if they can eliminate at least 3 of 5 beach landing zones. All other outcomes are a historical draw.

TABLETOP

The scenario requires a 12'x4' tabletop, with a 4" grid representing 2.5km. Bocage, urban, and soft ground grids are shown on the map. The tabletop should be set up according to the map below, with deployment areas noted for both sides.

DEPLOYMENT

The German player deploys first, with no more than two bunkers in any one space. All allied forces begin off table. LZs and Drop Zones are marked. The allies start with the first turn each day. Each of the 7 players receives their own Command Post.

SCENARIO NOTES

The traditional Rommel game scale is bumped up here, so that grids represent more kilometers, the turns per day are fewer, and a unit is an entire battalion.

- (1) Both sides begin each day with 0 Ops dice. Germans only roll 3d6 on their opening nighttime turn.
- (2) For the duration of the game, all German units that use strategic movement are subject to allied air attack. Roll a d6 for each unit. On a 1-3 lose one step.
- (3) One German bunker in each grid space may be employed as 105mm artillery so long as there is another German unit in the same space. Bunkers used as artillery must be "tipped" as normal for artillery.
- (4) Each Allied Command Post should be given 2 tactics for "Naval Gunfire." These new tactics cost ZERO ops dice to invoke, but are otherwise used as normal tactics.
- (5) Use the rules for Airborne and Amphibious landings.
- (6) German armored formations cannot move until Turn 8 on June 6th. On Turns 2, 4, and 6 of that day, Germans may roll a d6 for earlier release, requiring a "6."

GERMAN BRIEFING

We are receiving reports across the Normandy sector of firefights and enemy movements. This could be a deception, or it might be the beginning to the invasion. You must deploy all bunkers and minefields before the scenario begins.
