RUSSIAN STEPPE PAPER VILLAGES

These are free paper buildings you can print and assemble at home for your winter battles on the barren Russian steppe. If printed on 8.5"x11" paper, they will scale to roughly 3mm—a size our club finds ideal for microarmor or 6mm scale miniature battles. They also look great with our paper armies for the Winter Storm campaign.

Tabs are not included, you'll want to remember to leave yourself a little extra paper to fold and glue the buildings together on one end. You might wish to also include some triangular tabs along the peaks to help glue down the roof.

Unlike our paper armies, we did not hire a professional artist to draw these. Greg made them in Microsoft Paint, so if you print them larger than the intended scale, they may not look quite as convincing as they do in their natural, 3mm scale!

ADDING SNOW

If you want to jazz up your paper buildings with some extra effort, water down some white latex caulk. Using a toothpick or old paint brush, apply some of the caulk to the roof edges for snowy rooftops!

White paint works too, but caulk gives you a 3D look for heavier snow.
